THE LIMITED EDITION

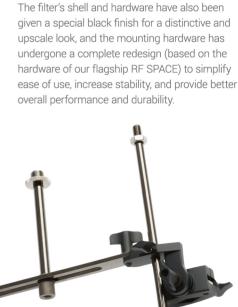
